

CALL FOR application to the UEHAS student exchange programs

UEHAS is an interdisciplinary program by Department of Urban Engineering (DUE) and School of International Health (SIH) of the University of Tokyo and the six partner universities in Thailand and Indonesia, namely, (i) Asian Institute of Technology, (ii) Chulalongkorn University, (iii) Thammasat University, Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology (SIIT) (iv) Mahidol University, (v) Padjadjaran University, and (vi) Indonesia University. As one of our activities, we offer 2-week field exercise courses and a 3-month exchange program for the graduate students of the University of Tokyo. The details of these programs are written below.

1. Eligibility

Full-time graduate students of the University of Tokyo are eligible to these programs.

2. Course detail

There are **short-term** (ca.2 weeks) and **long-term** (ca. 3 months) courses. The course detains are listed on the next page. You may select up to two courses when you apply, but are allowed to join only one unless there is any vacancy. Note that the numbers of students for each program are subject to change depending on the availability of the funding. The UHEAS office is now trying to allocate more funds to increase the number of students from the ones listed in the table.

- 3. UEHAS support to the students
- (i) A return air-ticket from Japan to Thailand/Indonesia (Not provided to any students who come back to the universities from which they were graduated.)
- (ii) Local accommodation/trip/study allowance by JASSO (Available only for qualified Japanese students: Please ask details for UEHAS office.)
- (iii) Accommodation for the long-term program.
- 4. Required documents for application
- (i) Application documents
 - a. Application form (Form 1)
 - b. Official academic transcripts
 - c. A copy of TOEFL/TOEIC/other English test score
 - d. A scanned copy of your passport
- (ii) Submission procedure
